

MICROPHONES & SPEAKER MANAGEMENT

FACT SHEET

Granting everyone an equal opportunity to speak will ensure your Q&A and debate sessions are inclusive and accessible to all, guaranteeing everyone is heard and has their say.

The IML Connector places a built-in conference microphone in each attendee's hand, giving everyone a voice and ensuring it's heard loud and clear.

The microphone feature is activated simply by pressing a button on the keypad and speaking into it in the same way that you would into any other microphone.

The system replaces the need for roving microphones, making Q&A and debate sessions more efficient and effective.



COST EFFECTIVE AND EFFICIENT

Participants have instant access to a personal microphone, removing the need to employ assistants with roving microphones, and consequently making Q&A sessions and debates more dynamic and faster paced.

GREATER CONTROL

Microphones can be activated and deactivated instantly at any stage of your event, giving you greater control over live discussions and Q&A sessions. The microphone queue can be available to all on a first-come, first-served basis, or can be limited to certain groups, such as those with speaking rights, providing for a more focused and structured debate.

ADDED VALUE

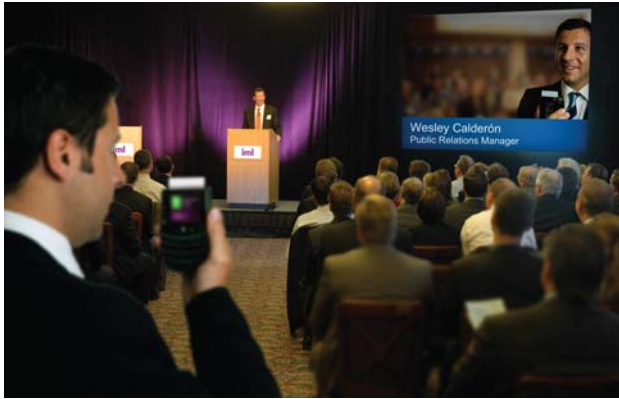
The IML Connector combines its conference microphone feature with instant voting and texting, enabling you to gauge audience opinion and address subjects raised during Q&A sessions. It also features a color screen, multiple audio channels for simultaneous interpretation and assisted listening and a built-in speaker for distributed PA.

GET RESULTS!

Display instant results live to your audience to generate further debate and discussion, and then act upon the outputs created from the conversation.



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IDENTIFY SPEAKERS

Participants who wish to speak can join a virtual line by pressing a button. When speaking, the red tally light on the IML Connector makes speakers easy to spot for cameras and their name and information can be displayed live on-screen.

BALANCED DEBATE

Information about participants, such as their job title and region, can be displayed next to their name in the queue. This allows the presenter to facilitate a broader debate by selecting a diverse range of speakers.

MULTIPLE AUDIO CHANNELS & SIMULTANEOUS INTERPRETATION

Use the IML Connector's multiple audio channels to record important meeting conversations or as a tool to assist the hearing impaired. It can also be used to play different streams of audio, allowing users to select which one to listen to. As a receiver for simultaneous interpretation, users can select their language and hear the appropriate audio through their headphones.



DISTRIBUTED PA

The IML Connector's built-in speaker enables the devices to be used as a distributed PA system. It also reinforces participants' hearing while other audience members are speaking into their built-in microphones.
